



Merit Scholarship Application

Purpose: Davis Technical College merit-based scholarships may be awarded to students based on their previous educational technical accomplishments, commitment to the field and their career goals. Scholarships are to be used by all students to further their technical pursuits for employment. All scholarships will be awarded to selected students upon enrollment at Davis Technical College.

Application Deadlines:

Open enrollment programs will have as their deadline the first Friday of each month. If the first Friday is a non-school day the application deadline will be extended to the next school day.

Practical Nursing applications will be accepted on the first Friday of the month beginning two months prior to the start of the semester.

Awards can be applied to any tuition assessed subsequent to the award offering. The College does not pay scholarship awards retroactively.

Application Requirements: Any adult student is eligible to apply. Applicants must verify lawful presence in the United States (US citizen or a legal Resident Alien).

Scholarship Information:

- Students must have a Davis Tech student ID number.
- Students on scholarship must be enrolled or intending to enroll in a regular, ongoing Davis Tech program that leads to an approved certificate.
- Students on scholarship are expected to be enrolled at least ½ time (12 hours per week) or if an eligible program is offered less than ½ time they are expected to be enrolled the maximum number of hours per week the program is available.
- Enrolled students applying for scholarships must be meeting the Davis Tech's minimum standards for satisfactory progress (67%) and attendance (85%) to be considered for merit-based awards.
- Failure to maintain satisfactory progress or attendance will result in a withdrawal of the award.
- A student can be awarded no more than two merit-based scholarships within a 12-month period.
- Students must officially accept the scholarship by providing a thank you letter to the donor and submit a copy of the same thank you letter to the Financial Aid Office.

Selection Process: The Davis Tech scholarship committee will review complete applications and identify those students to be awarded scholarships.

Student applications will be reviewed on the following criteria:

1. **Accomplishments in Applied Technology Education:** Grades, competency levels, and participation in student organizations.
2. **Applied Technology Education Goal:** The student's career goal is in line with previous and proposed training and the student shows a commitment to the training field.
3. **Other Achievements:** General academics, community service, and work experience, etc.
4. **Strength of Recommendations:** Recommendations should provide specific and unique information that assists committee members in distinguishing the student's capability and merit.
