



DAVIS APPLIED TECHNOLOGY COLLEGE AND INTERMOUNTAIN HEALTH CARE NURSING DIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS

Purpose: Davis Applied Technology College (DATC) and Intermountain Healthcare have established the Nursing Diversity Scholarship which supports the core values of trust, excellence, accountability, and mutual respect. This Scholarship builds on the Intermountain Health Care mission and vision by encouraging a diverse workforce, which will be more responsive to patients' varied cultural beliefs and practices. Culture includes the values, beliefs, standards, language, thinking patterns, behaviors, communication styles, etc. Cultural diversity among nurses promotes positive health outcomes.

Application DEADLINE: Scholarship applications are accepted prior to the beginning of the courses.

Application Requirements: Any adult student who is enrolled in a Practical Nursing program full time and maintaining satisfactory progress and attendance -OR- is enrolled at least half time in the Nursing Assistant program is eligible to apply. Preference will be given to applicants with culturally diverse backgrounds who demonstrate financial need. Additional points may be given to applicants with bilingual skills and foreign language fluency. Each applicant will submit a brief essay describing his or her cultural diversity. Recipients will be encouraged to help with Intermountain Healthcare and DATC's outreach to culturally diverse high school students for the purpose of encouraging them to enter the nursing profession. Applicants must be a U.S. Citizen or eligible non-citizen with valid evidence of permanent residency in the United States. Funds are not accessible to non-resident students.

Scholarship Information

- Students must have a DATC student ID number. To enroll, visit www.datc.edu and follow instructions on the Enroll Now tab
- Students must be willing to submit an application for Federal Financial Assistance (www.fafsa.ed.gov) to the Department of Education.
- Students must be enrolled in or intending to enroll in a regular, ongoing DATC Practical Nurse or Nursing Assistant program that leads to an approved credential.
- Enrolled students applying for scholarship must be meeting the school's minimum standards for satisfactory progress (67%) and attendance (85%) to be considered.
- Failure to maintain satisfactory progress and/or attendance after receiving a scholarship will result in withdrawal of the award.
- Applicants will be notified by mail of their selection within 15 workdays following receipt of their application.
- Students must officially accept the scholarship by providing a Thank You letter to the donor and submitting a copy to the Financial Aid office at DATC.

Selection Process: The Davis Applied Technology College Financial Aid and Scholarship Office will review applications for consideration. Awards can be applied to any tuition assessed after the award offering. The college does not pay scholarship awards retroactively.
