

EMST 1000 Emergency Medical Technician Admissions Checklist

The EMST 1000 Emergency Medical Technician course is open to qualified high school and adult students. High school students must be seniors and 18 years old within 120 days of completing the course. Students must meet the following requirements and submit the required documentation to be admitted to the program:

- Adult students must have a high school diploma or equivalent.
- Pass DATC Admissions Tests in reading and math*.
- Provide two copies of CPR certification* from one of the following agencies:
 - American Heart Association-Healthcare Provider
 - American Red Cross-Professional Rescuer
 - National Safety Council-Infant, One and Two Man Adult CPR
- Provide two copies of TB skin tests results*.
- Provide one passport size photograph with name printed on the back.
- Provide copy of current driver's license.
- Submit signed Consent Form.

*Completed within the past 6 months.
